



**Specific Additional Fees
for Canadian Semen Shipments
Breeding Contract Addendum**

Clients who wish to receive semen shipments in Canada must read and sign this contract addendum in order to book a breeding to an October Hill Farm stallion. This addendum was added in March of 2009 to address the additional fees involved in the shipment of semen as imposed by the USDA and the CFIA (Canadian Food Inspection Agency).

1. The USDA requires the certification and signature of a USDA representative on each shipment bound for Canada. The USDA representative must visit our farm each time one of these shipments is prepared and a fee of \$320.00 is charged by the USDA for each visit. This fee will be added to the mare owner's October Hill Farm account, and includes both the export permit and the USDA vet fees.
2. The Mare Owner is responsible for obtaining an import permit from the CFIA. October Hill Farm recommends the purchase of a multiple use permit. October Hill Farm will not pay for this permit.
3. The Mare Owner must forward the import permit to October Hill Farm immediately upon receipt. October Hill Farm recommends sending the permit by registered or certified mail or by other trackable means **at least one week prior** to the expected collection date.
4. October Hill Farm must have the import permit prior to scheduling a collection for the Mare Owner.
5. The Mare Owner must contact October Hill Farm by 12pm CST the day prior to a scheduled collection to ensure the timely delivery of the semen. This will ensure that the USDF representative is available to prepare the documents for timely shipment to your location.
6. All other fees and expenses apply as put forth in the breeding contract.
